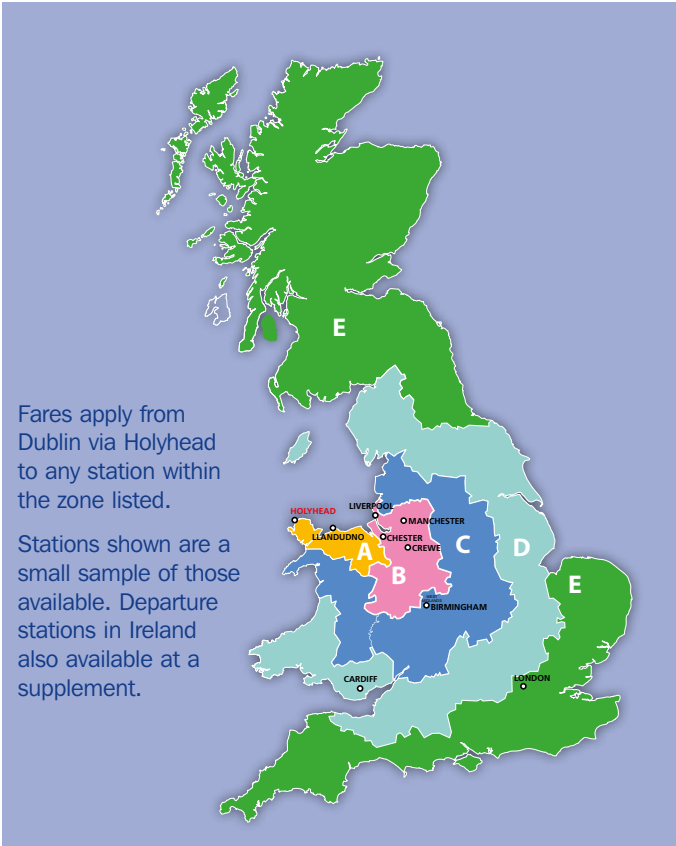



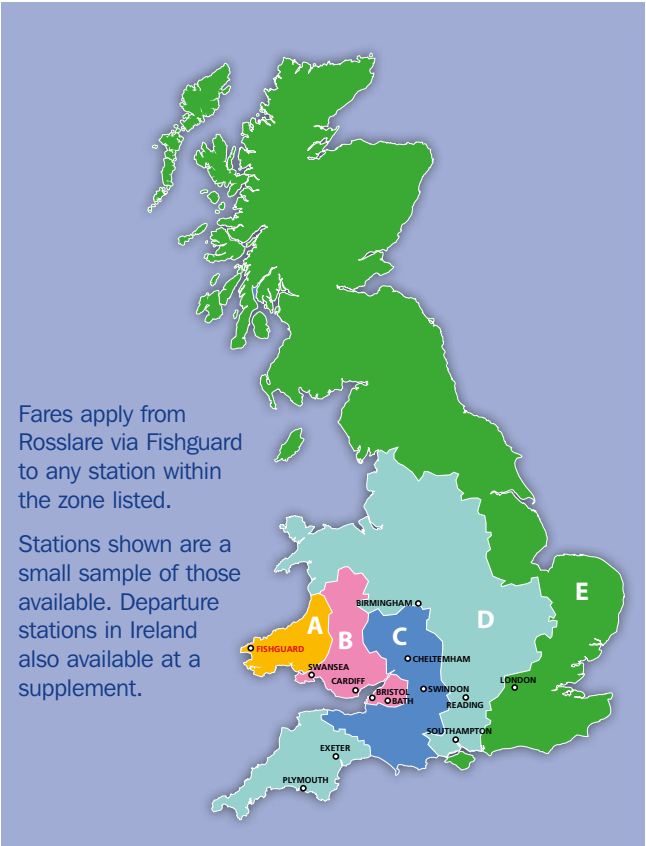

Through SailRail tickets will be valid for travel on the coach at no additional charge. Fares do not include transfers between Belfast Central Station and Belfast Port.

# TERMS & CONDITIONS



## Travel by Sea

Carriage is subject to the Terms and Conditions of Business of Stena Line Limited and associate carriers. Details are available on our website or on request.

## Rail Travel

Rail travel is subject to the relevant terms and conditions of the particular railway undertaking and where appropriate, the provisions of the Convention concerning the International Carriage by Rail (Cotif) of 9 May 1998 including the Uniform Regulations concerning the contract of International Rail passenger and Luggage Traffic (CIV) contained in Appendix A of the Convention. Details are available on request.

## General Information

Prices are valid until further notice, we may change the services described in this publication, including prices and departure dates and times. As all connections cannot be guaranteed you are strongly advised to check train times before travelling. SailRail fares exclude travel on the LUAS system in Dublin and the London Underground.

## Advance Fares

Can only be purchased up to 18:00 hours the day before travel and only valid on the date and train services shown on ticket. They are subject to limited availability and if there is no availability a Standard fare will be charged. You may not start, break, resume or end your journey at any intermediate station except to change from/to connecting trains shown on ticket or itinerary.

## Standard Fares

Can be purchased at any time and when Advance fares are not available.

## Payment

Full payment is required at the time of booking. A €6 charge applies to credit card bookings made by phone, no charge for payment by debit card. If your journey commences from Dublin, Dun Laoghaire or Rosslare ports, please collect your SailRail ticket from the Stena Line ticket desk prior to boarding. When your journey commences at an Irish station, we require 10 working days to ensure you receive your ticket in time. However you may also purchase tickets from selected Iarnród Éireann stations - see back or call Irish Rail on 1850 366 222 for details.

## Cancellation Charges

For cancellations a €18.50 per booking administration fee will apply. Cancellation charges prior to departure vary per ticket type. Advance fares are non-refundable at any time and standard fares are non-refundable after departure.

## Carriage of Bicycles

Bicycles incur a €12 single charge with Stena Line and you are advised to check with the relevant railway operator that they can be carried on the train and are subject to the availability of space.
